Have you made so many quilts that you have given one to everyone you know? Do you wish you could make quilts for people who really need them? Is your New Year's resolution to be more involved in helping others? The Quilting Angels have an answer for you! We make quilts and other sewn projects to give to charitable organizations and individuals who need quilts and someone to show that they care.

We meet every month on the third Monday of the month. Quilter's Emporium generously allows us to meet in the shop and sew for charity. You don't have to bring anything except your sewing machine. All of our quilts and projects are made out of donated fabrics. I have the quilt kits cut out and ready to sew. So you see, all we really need is you!

Last year, we donated quilts to Arms Wide Adoption Agency, Parks Youth Ranch, and Brigid's Hope. We donated prayer shawls to Dr. Dempsey, a breast cancer doctor, and lap quilts to Oncology Consultants for patients undergoing chemotherapy. We donated fidget quilts to Alzheimer's patients; baby quilts, burp cloths, nursing pads and nursing covers to a hospital sponsored community baby shower; pillowcases to hospice patients; and made heart shaped pillows for breast cancer patients.

The next time we meet to sew quilt tops is Monday, January 21, 2019. Anyone who would like to help is welcome to join us. Any level of experience is okay. We have helped many beginners gain experience in piecing quilts. We start sewing at 10:00 and finish up around 3:00. If you have never come before, we hope you will consider giving the Quilting Angels a try. We are a friendly bunch, and the rewards are worth your time.
